ORDER ADOPTING CALENDAR FOR 2019

BY ORDER of the Superior Courts of the Chattahoochee Judicial Circuit, the attached calendar constitutes the official schedule for the year 2019 and takes PRIORITY over any matters not scheduled thereupon, subject to the Uniform Superior Court Rules and applicable Georgia law.

The designation "(P.J.)" on the schedule denotes the "Presiding Judge" for that week. This Judge will be responsible for hearing all Temporary Protective Orders, Instanters, Search Warrants and other walk-in matters requiring immediate review by a Superior Court Judge. "M", "T", "W", "R" and "F" indicate, respectively, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday as the specific days during any given week in which certain matters shall be scheduled and heard.

Cases in the Superior Courts of Chattahoochee, Harris, Marion, Talbot and Taylor Counties shall not be assigned exclusively to a specific Judge unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

Civil, domestic relations and all other non-criminal cases filed in the Superior Court of Muscogee County shall be randomly assigned by the Clerk of said Court among all seven Judges as provided in Ga. Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 3.1 and 3.2 to the end that each Judge is allocated an equal number of cases. For these cases, the assigned Judge shall schedule all hearings and other proceedings and such Judge shall retain exclusive control and responsibility for these cases as provided in Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 3.3.

Pursuant to Ga. Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 8.4, the parties and counsel in the first 10 actions on a published civil and domestic trial calendar in this Circuit shall appear ready for trial on the date specified unless otherwise directed by the assigned Judge. Additionally, continuances will not be granted merely by agreement of counsel and actions will not be removed from a published trial calendar except by Court direction pursuant to Ga. Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 8.5.

Criminal matters indicted or accused in the Superior Court of Muscogee County shall be randomly assigned by the Clerk of said Court among all seven Judges as provided in Ga. Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 3.1 and 3.2 to the end that each Judge is allocated an equal number of cases. Unless otherwise directed by the Court, said Clerk shall schedule all hearings and other proceedings with respect to all criminal cases assigned to each Judge. The assigned Judge shall retain exclusive control and responsibility for these cases as provided in Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 3.3.

Pursuant to Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 32.2, no criminal case shall be postponed or removed from a trial calendar in this Circuit except by the direction of the Judge presiding over the case.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Order, and unless otherwise ordered by the Court, petitions alleging violation of probation shall be filed within thirty (30) days of execution of any probation arrest warrant.

Parties and counsel are reminded to adhere to the conflict rules set forth at Ga. Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 17.1, including the provision of timely notice of the conflict(s) and a proposed resolution of the conflict(s) to the proper Court(s) and parties.

Members and representatives of the news media are reminded of the provisions set forth in Ga. Unif. R. Sup. Ct. 22, and shall take all steps requested by such rule pertaining to written notice and service of requests thereunder.


